Being a parent in a Christian context in today's modern world can be a daunting task! To assist and equip parents in their responsibility as "first teachers," **Family Faith Formation Sessions** for parents will be scheduled at the same time as the morning Parish School of Religion (PSR) sessions every week. For parents with children in grades Kindergarten through sixth (6), these sessions will be held in the St. Margaret Room from **11:15AM until 12:30PM** and will be facilitated by various speakers. **At least one parent per student is required to attend each session**, though it is preferable that both parents attend these sessions.

Such engagement and the witness of parents learning alongside their children coupled with their intentional decision to bring the whole family to Mass weekly and on Holy Days communicates to young people that life is more than work or sports (as important as are these activities!) Rather, it communicates the message that we are worth more than we do and shows this not just by words but also by family action!
