## **EUCHARISTIC MIRACLES**

Dear St. Margaret/St. Thomas,

One beautiful truth we can take away from the miracle of the Eucharist is that God meets us where we are, not where we pretend to be. The Eucharistic Miracle of Lanciano occurred in a Basilian monastery dedicated to St. Longinus (the soldier who "thrust his lance into His side, and immediately blood and water flowed out", John 19:34) in 750, and it is a prime example of the Lord's desire to encounter us and strengthen our faith.

A monastic priest was having doubts that the bread and wine truly became Jesus' Flesh and Blood during the consecration. His reservations regarding the True Presence were a stumbling block to him, but he remained obedient. One day as he said the words of consecration during Mass, the Host turned into Flesh in his hands, and the wine of the chalice turned into Blood. The priest wept with joy. Everyone in attendance saw the transformation. Shortly after, the Blood coagulated into five globules, which the onlookers connected to the five Wounds of Christ. The matter was investigated and proclaimed a miracle, and the host was placed in a special vessel, which is still on display in Lanciano today.

Many scientific tests have been performed on the relics over the centuries with the most recent being in the 1970s. Some of the findings include:

- The Flesh and Blood are a human sample.
- Both are of the same blood type, AB (the same as found on the Shroud of Turin).
- This Blood was described as having properties of fresh blood.
- The Flesh is "fresh" muscular tissue of the heart, not dead tissue.

Praise You, Jesus, for all the ways the Incarnation reveals You to us across time!


