## WORD OF GOD SUNDAY RESOUCES FOR SCRIPTURE STUDY

Today the Universal Church celebrates the 2nd Sunday in Ordinary time, also designated as Word of God Sunday by Pope Francis in his Apostolic Letter "Aperuit Illis: Instituting the Sunday of the Word of God." The Holy Father in his letter exhorts the faithful to explore "the inexhaustible riches contained in that constant dialogue between the Lord and his people." To that end, we are providing several resources that we believe will enhance your prayer life and enable you to better understand God's call in your life through scripture. We hope you find this helpful.

These words contain a great teaching. The Bible cannot be just the heritage of some, much less a collection of books for the benefit of a privileged few. It belongs above all to those called to hear its message and to recognize themselves in its words. At times, there can be a tendency to monopolize the sacred text by restricting it to certain circles or to select groups. It cannot be that way. The Bible is the book of the Lord's people, who, in listening to it, move from dispersion and division towards unity. The word of God unites believers and makes them one people. (No. 4)

They sit down at table, and Jesus takes the bread, blesses it, breaks it and offers it to them. At that moment, their eyes are opened, and they recognize him. This scene clearly demonstrates the unbreakable bond between sacred Scripture and the Eucharist. (No 8)

And let them remember that prayer should accompany the reading of Sacred Scripture, so that God and man may talk together; for "we speak to Him when we pray; we hear Him when we read the divine saying." (No. 25)
