TALITHA KOUM: "LITTLE GIRL, I SAY TO YOU, ARISE!" (MK. 5:41) (KORUKOLLU DEANERY, DIOCESE OF VIJAYAWADA, INDIA)

Dear Friends in Christ,

I wanted to share with you all a ministry that I started in my diocese with several of my brother priests and bishop about 5 years ago called "Talitha Koum". The current situation of young girls, specifically those in poverty, in my Deanery of Korukollu is very difficult.

The girls in India are considered to be an extra burden. Often, they are abused, harassed, ill-treated, and exploited. From childhood they are looked down upon, less loved, less cared for and fed less even by their own mothers. Those who are victimized victimize others. Very often they are abandoned and killed. From early childhood the girls must do the household work and care their younger siblings. There is no security for the girl children either in their own house or outside facing the challenges and risks, including sexual abuse, flesh trade, and molestations.

They are used for working in the FISHERIES, to care the SHEEP and CATTLE or are employed as domestic laborers where they must face the same cycle of life situations and risk factors. Having been denied of their childhood days they carry scars and wounds with traumas of life. At the tender age of 10-17 they are tortured, married to their own close relations (uncles or first cousins), who are very often three times older than themselves, only to be harassed, ill-treated, beaten and to shoulder heavy burdens of life ending in broken family ties. There exists flesh trade, trafficking abuses, etc. even after marriage.

The DIOCESE OF VIJAYAWADA has undertaken the mission of educating these poor girls. We admit ten girls from each parish. We have 104 parishes in the diocese. KORUKOLLU is my deanery with ten parishes each with 100 girls. I am with the voice of my Bishop, planning to help for their education and other expenses. (See pictures on the next page.)

Objectives:

- To provide a secure shelter for the girl children who are facing difficult situations, risk factors and many distressing conditions of life in which the girls are suffocated.
- To empower them through education, formation, and counseling.
- To reduce child labor and child marriage.
- · To facilitate their integral growth towards a better family and better society.
- To help them to overcome the traumas and scars of life.
- To build up their self-confidence being aware of their own potentials.

THE DETAILS OF THE EXPENSES FOR 100 CHILDREN IN A YEAR (USD \$)

EDUCATION: $100 \times 350 = $35,000.00$

FOOD: \$6,500.00

MEDICINE: \$2,000.00 CLOTHING: \$3,200.00 COUNSELING: \$1,000.00

TOTAL: \$47,700.00 (USD: Forty-seven Thousand, Seven Hundred)
