PONDERINGS OF THE PEDAL-N-PADRE

Dear Parish Family,

Peace in the Lord Jesus Christ this Pentecost Sunday! "Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Your faithful and enkindle in them the fire of Your love!" I just finished a novena to the Holy Spirit asking Him to hallow the many parishioners, staff members, and volunteers that bless our community of St. Margaret and St. Thomas. First, I want to thank you all for your prayers for my safe travels on my vacation two weeks ago in the deserts of Moab, UT. God's creation is incredibly beautiful, especially from the seat of a mountain bike! (See back cover for pics.)

As we move into the new fiscal year, I want to take this opportunity in my bulletin article to share with you some staff changes that will begin on July 1st. As some of you know, one of the most challenging responsibilities as a pastor is balancing all the things it takes to keep a Church parish running well for the greater glory of God and for the salvation of souls!

This can mean anything from burnt-out lights and clogged toilets to finding the right volunteers to support our many ministries, to beautiful liturgy and faithfully forming your spiritual lives through Word and Sacrament (and there is a multitude of other things between those!). Thus, as Moses' father-in law, Jethro, suggested to Moses in Exodus 18:13-26, I decided it would be best for me to share these responsibilities, especially with some of my staff members. Though this already happens significantly with staff members and volunteers (thank you all!!!), with Fr. Laz leaving at the end of the month and unsure as to when a new associate pastor will be coming to replace him, I thought it would be prudent for me to break up the staff organization into 4 different "teams": janitorial/maintenance, administration, liturgical music, and ministry.

Each team will be supervised by a "team leader" who will help lead and guide their respective team. Deacon Tim will be leading the Janitorial/Maintenance Team, made up of Michael Galjour (maintenance), Cade Sanzone (HVAC), Peggy Desselle (janitorial), and Brennan Bishop (janitorial). Mary Herbert (Administrative Assistant) will lead the Administrative Team, made up of Tammy Resetar (receptionist/bulletin/cemetery) and Peggy Desselle (collections). Laura DeBenedetto will lead the Liturgical Music Team, made up of all our cantors and accompanists. And finally, Baleigh Henderson (PSR, high school youth ministry, digital media, adult formation, OCIA liaison) will lead our Ministry Team, made up of Melissa Berghausen (junior high youth ministry, sacraments, child protection coordinator). Diaconate ministry, the associate pastor, and grounds (under Jason Summers) will report directly to me as pastor. If there is any feedback from parishioners about respective team responsibilities, it would be best to first approach the team leader before you approach me. This will make things easier for me and hopefully lead to timelier and more efficient operations in our mission here at St. Margaret and St. Thomas.

Finally, please note that the only significant changes in job descriptions will be in youth ministry and sacramental coordination. Because of the soon-to-happen changes in confirmation formation (7th graders receiving the sacrament of confirmation), it will no longer be necessary to have high school PSR after this year. Thus, I thought it would be best to transfer high school youth ministry to Baleigh Henderson, our CRE, so that we can hopefully encourage our high schoolers to continue to be formed in their faith on Sunday evenings as well as youth ministry on Wednesday evenings. This means that Melissa Berghausen will continue to meet with our junior high parishioners on Wednesday evenings at 5:00PM, while Baleigh will meet with our high school students at 6:30PM, in addition to some kind of faith formation on Sunday evenings after our 7th graders begin to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation (TBA). Melissa will then take on the responsibility of sacramental coordinator – helping plan our baptisms, weddings, and funerals – with Peggy Desselle and Landon Goings assisting as wedding coordinators.

A special "Thank You" to all the staff here at St. Margaret and St. Thomas for their work towards building the Kingdom of God!


