## PONDERINGS OF THE PEDAL-N-PADRE

Dear Parish Family,

Peace in the Lord Jesus Christ! This weekend is especially significant as we celebrate the Feast of our Patroness, St. Margaret, Queen of Scotland. I wanted to dedicate this article to exploring her remarkable life.

Born around 1045 AD in the Kingdom of Hungary, St. Margaret was the daughter of the exiled English Prince Edward (son of King Edmund Ironside) and Princess Agatha of Hungary. Her father was eventually called back to England as a potential heir to the throne. However, the Norman conquest of England in 1066 AD forced Margaret and her family to flee once again. While attempting to return to Hungary, a shipwreck instead landed them on the shores of Scotland. There, King Malcolm III offered them refuge. King Malcolm soon fell in love with Margaret, marrying her around 1070 AD. The couple had eight children, including three sons who would all become kings of Scotland.

As queen, Margaret became instrumental in reforming both the Scottish court and the Church in Scotland. Renowned for her devout Catholic faith, she promoted piety, encouraged the observance of religious practices, and worked to align ecclesiastical customs more closely with Roman traditions. Her influence led to the building of many churches and monasteries, and she personally established hostels for pilgrims and travelers.

St. Margaret was most known for her immense charitable works toward the poor. Her deep compassion for the less fortunate was a defining characteristic of her reign. Tragically, she died on November 16, 1093, just days after receiving the devastating news of her husband and eldest son's deaths in battle.

Due to her deep devotion and the powerful way, she used her noble influence to serve the less fortunate, Margaret was canonized a saint by Pope Innocent IV in 1250. She remains venerated today as a model of Christian queenship and the Patroness of Scotland.

Reflecting on St. Margaret's life, two key lessons stand out. First, we see how God can use tragedy to fulfill His loving will. This is the core mystery of the Cross and the hope we cling to during life's challenges. Margaret's family endured the tragedies of exile and a near-fatal shipwreck. Yet, those very events were what led her to become Queen of Scotland, granting her the influence to transform the lives of thousands of her countrymen through her deep charity and love for God.

Secondly, St. Margaret was one of the few laywomen canonized at that time. Her life powerfully affirms that all of us are called to holiness. She demonstrates that holding wealth and power does not have to be a trap of materialism or self-gain. Instead, she used her elevated status entirely for the greater glory of God and to bring service to those in desperate need.

I hope that the life of St. Margaret, Queen of Scotland can be a true inspiration to us all in our walk toward holiness and our journey to eternal life.


