Dear Parish Family,


Peace in the Lord Jesus Christ this First Sunday of the Advent Season!

"Lord teach us how to pray!" These were the words of the Apostles to Jesus in Luke 11:1 after they had seen Him praying in a certain place. I believe these words should be the prayer of us all: "Teach us how to pray!" This Advent, I plan to help you do just that with the Advent book that **St. Margaret has gifted** to each family.

The title of the book is "Into the Deep" by Dan Burke. Dan Burke is a national speaker and founder of the Avila Institute, which is geared to teaching people (particularly the laity) how to go deeper in their spiritual life and to live a life of discipleship with a day-to-day relationship with Jesus.

Because the book study this past Lent was such a success, I decided to host a small Advent book study as well, rather than having an Advent mission this year. It is a short, 90-page book that teaches people how to go deeper in their prayer life. The chapter titles will give you a small glimpse of the book:

- "Your desire for God, God's desire for you"
- "Discovery Prayer"
- "Essential Elements for Progress in Prayer"
- "Making a Solemn Commitment to God"
- "Step-by-Step into the Presence of God"
- "Winning the Battle of Prayer"
- "Experiencing God in Prayer"
- "A Final Word of Encouragement: Be Scrappy"



The book study will take place on **Tuesdays**, **December 9th**, **16th**, and **23rd**, from **6:00PM** to **7:00PM** in **St. Margaret Church**. As I did for the Lenten book study, I will discuss each chapter while providing my own commentary.

The opening paragraph to the Forward states: "Prayer is difficult, joyful, challenging, and life changing. The journey into prayer, into the heart of God, is the reason we were made; it is the reason God brought us into existence."

The Advent Season is all about silent waiting for the coming of the Messiah. My hope is that this Advent season each of us can "go a little deeper" in silent prayer with the God who became a little child. Please join us for this book study so that the Holy Spirit **can** "teach you how to pray."
