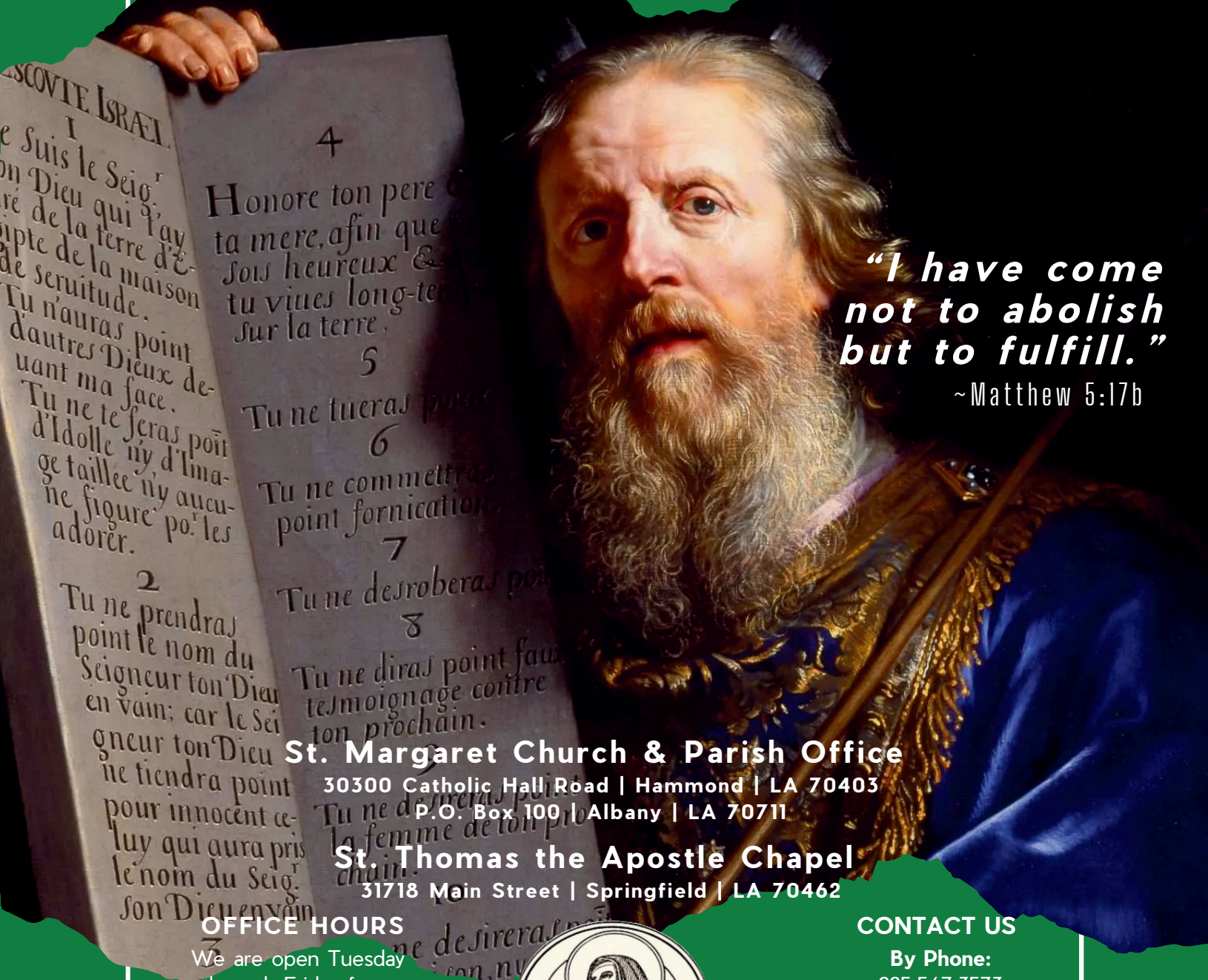

PONDERINGS OF THE PEDAL-N-PADRE

Dear Parish Family,

Peace in the Lord Jesus Christ! It is already here...**Lent begins next week!** The Season of Lent is a profound transition in the liturgical year, intended to be a time of transformation for Catholics who take it seriously.

In Scripture, numbers often have real significance. The number **40** often symbolizes a time of purification, trial, preparation, and transformation. We see this throughout salvation history:

- **The Great Flood** in the Book of Genesis lasted 40 days (Gn 7:12).
- **The Israelites** wandered the desert for 40 years before they could enter the Promised Land (Nm 14:33-34).
- **Moses** was on Mt. Sinai for 40 days before receiving the Ten Commandments (Ex 24:18).
- **Jesus**, as we see in next weekend's Gospel, spent 40 days and 40 nights in the desert tempted by the devil immediately after His Baptism (Mt 4:1-2).

The Season of Lent is a time to reexamine our lives, recommit to our calling as disciples of Jesus, repent of unconfessed sins, and perform acts of penance—prayer, fasting, or almsgiving—to better prepare our hearts for the central message of the Christian faith: the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of our Lord.

FASTING AND ABSTINENCE

Remember that the Church requires those over the age of 14 to **abstain from meat** on the Fridays of Lent (unless one is ill). This practice unites us with the sacrifice of Christ and reminds us that it was on this day that Jesus gave up His flesh for the life of the world.

Additionally, Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 (unless ill) are required to **fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday**. Fasting typically means eating only one full meal, with the possibility of two smaller meals that do not equal a full-size meal. Snacks or drinks (other than water) are not allowed between meals.

Let us make this Lent truly what it is intended to be for our spiritual lives, so that we are prepared for Holy Week and can more deeply enter into the Paschal Mystery.

EVENTS AROUND THE PARISH

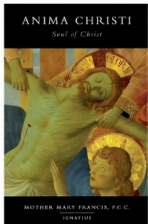
ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT
